2019-20 SCHOOL YEAR REGISTRATION INFORMATION

REGISTRATION DEADLINE: MAY 10, 2019

Dear Parents:

Registration paperwork for the 2019-20 school year is enclosed. All registration forms and fees are due in the front office no later than May 10, 2019. If you are moving and your child will not be attending Rosemont School next year, we ask that you please contact the school at 847-825-0144 right away to notify us. Below are some important details regarding your child's registration and next year's school year.

SCHOOL FEES

Registration Fee: \$70 per student (Preschool through Grade 8)

(Registration fees for students (K-8) on the state lunch program are \$10 per student)

Kindergarten Graduation Fee: \$35 per student *(Fee includes t-shirt and graduation DVD)*

8th Grade Graduation Fee: \$95 per student *(Fee includes cap & gown, autograph book, t-shirt, graduation DVD)*

Gym Uniform Fee: \$13 (t-shirt); \$13 (shorts) - (Grades 4 through 8)

Swim Uniform Fee: \$25 (girls); \$30 (boys) - (Grades 5 through 8)

Polar Heart Monitor Straps: \$15 – (Grades 5 through 8)

NOTE: All fees are payable by cash or check. If paying by check, please write separate checks for each fee. Checks are due by the May 10th deadline, but will not be deposited until after July 1st. Registrations not received by the deadline will incur a late fee of \$10 per student. Late fees will increase to \$20 per student after 30 days. The school supply list for your child is enclosed. These can also be printed from our website.

FIRST DAY OF SCHOOL & HOURS

The first day of school for Kindergarten through 8th grade students is Tuesday, August 13th with a 2:00 p.m. early dismissal. Regular school hours are: Grades K through 5 – 8:30 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. - Junior High (Grades 6-8) - 8:25 a.m. (report to homeroom) to 3:00 p.m. The first day of school for Preschool is Wednesday, August 14th. Preschool hours are: 4-year-old program - 8:30 a.m. to 11:00 a.m. - 3-year-old program – 12:15 p.m. to 2:45 p.m. – Monday through Friday. The 2019-20 calendar is still being finalized and will be posted on our website once completed.

HEALTH REGULATIONS & DEADLINES

Per Illinois state law, students entering certain grades are required to submit proof of physical, dental, and vision exams. Below are the required grades and deadline dates. Please try to schedule your appointments over the summer months so that your child has their required exams on file on the first day of school. Most doctor's offices have the state required forms, but if needed, forms can be printed from our school website. If your child needs to administer any medication during the school day, a signed Self-Administration of Medication form needs to be submitted along with the medication to the front office. This form can be printed from our website or picked up in the school office.

VISION EXAMS – Required Grade: Kindergarten
Deadline: August 13, 2019

PHYSICAL EXAMS – Required Grades: Preschool, Kindergarten, 6th Grade
Deadline: August 13, 2019

DENTAL EXAMS – Required Grades: Kindergarten, 2nd Grade, 6th Grade
Deadline: April 12, 2020

SPORTS – ILLINOIS ELEMENTARY SCHOOL ASSOCIATION - REQUIRED FORMS

(Grades 5 – 8)

Per Illinois state law, students interested in trying out for any sports, including cheerleading, must submit the following two required forms by the first day of school on August 13, 2019. If your doctor's office does not have these required forms, they can be printed from our school website.

- 1) IESA Pre-Participation Examination Form
- 2) Concussion Information Sheet

LUNCH PERIODS & HOT LUNCH ORDERS

Lunch periods for the students are as follows:
Kindergarten through 4th Grade – 11:22 a.m. to 12:03 p.m.
5th through 8th Grade – 12:05 p.m. to 12:46 p.m.

If your child orders hot lunch, please note that order forms are sent home with your child on the first Friday of every month for the following month. Orders with payment are due back on the following Monday. Every child wanting hot lunch must submit an order form by the deadline, including those on the state lunch program. Order forms can also be printed from our website.

SUMMER OFFICE HOURS

The school will be open over the summer Monday through Thursday from 8:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m., and on Friday from 8:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m.
